Item 1: Update from CERF on Retinal Folds
CERF has responded to the AMSC's request for review of literature on retinal folds. After review and discussion with the researcher, the CERF Genetics Committee decided to change the status of retinal folds in our breed from certifiable to non-certifiable on CERF exams. This status applies to unilaterally and bilaterally fold- affected Miniature Schnauzers. Prior to this decision, retinal folds were not considered a significant finding in our breed. As with some other breeds, there was no evidence that folds in our breed were inherited or were associated with more severe forms of Retinal Dysplasia. In breeds where this defect was associated with more severe forms of the defect, folds were non-certifiable. This status change was inspired by the hard work of some dedicated breeders and the support of the board of directors.

Item 2: Update on Juvenile Renal Disease/ Dysplasia Dr. Mary Whitely has submitted a report outlining her progress thus far in her investigation of candidate genes for this defect in our breed. In summary, her report states

the following:

Dr. Whitely has examined the DNA of 20 Miniature Schnauzers searching for the same mutation that has been isolated in JRD affected Lhasa and Shih Tzu. Four of these dogs' DNA has to be reprocessed due to insufficient samples. Dr. Whitely is examining candidate genes, for general purposes we'll call the first two A and B.

So far, there is a 100% correlation of gene A with JRD affected Miniature Schnauzers. More dogs from our breed will be needed for comparison. Only one dog had the gene B, which is suspected as a possible second mutation in the Shih Tzu. She is still collecting DNA fragments for further sequencing of other candidate genes. Item 3: Pancreatitis Study at Texas A & M

Dr. Xenoulis is soliciting blood samples from our breed for research into pancreatitis and hyperlipidemia. Participation is simple, requiring a short questionnaire and a blood sample, at no cost to the breeder/owner. Participation will result in free serum triglyceride and cPLI testing for each sample submitted. Please see Appendix B for additional details and contact information.

Item 4: DVDs from AKC Canine Health Foundation Parent Club Health Conference

We have received a copy of the 4 DVDs from the conference. They include a number of interesting presentations, and the set is released to parent clubs for reproduction and distribution to club members. Topics include; Canine Genetic Disease-Ceroid Lipofuscinosis, Mending Heart Failure-Adult Stem Cells, Role of Chromosomes in Cancer, Genetic Impact of Disease Risk, Canine Cancer Research, Protein Metabolism, Advances in Assisted Reproduction, Nutrition and Osteoarthritis, Epilepsy and Neurologic Disease, Endocrine Disorders-including Hypothyroidism, Measuring Behavior and Temperament, and Vaccination Protocols.

The committee is looking for a cost-efficient means of reproducing the set so interested members may obtain a copy. A notice will appear in AMSCOPE when the copies are available. Cathi Rohrer volunteered to burn CD's for any AMSC Officer or Board Member who requests a copy from the Health Committee.

Legislative liaisons help their club influence local, state and federal legislative issues affecting purebred dogs and their owners.

- * Monitoring their local news and staying aware of issues which may impact our sport.
- * Alerting the AKC to pending legislative issues in their communities or states.
- * Presenting the views and interest of the purebred do fancy to lawmakers, other citizens and news media.
- * Receiving material, updates and advice from the AKC Canine Legislation Department and distributing information to fellow club members.
- * Organizing and motivating club members to

become active in the legislative process, and encouraging other interested fanciers to help advance legislation that will benefit purebred dog owners and breeders.

- * Sharing their club's experience and expertise with government officials, members of the community and other interested fanciers.
- * Preparing their clubs for action should a legislative initiative arise that requires input from purebred dog owners and breeders.

Cheryl Lyons spoke up in Riverside Country about spay and neutering legislation. We need members to be a part of a team for local responses. We are losing the battle to Animal Rights groups. If we keep on doing what we have done in the past, then the future looks dim. Local clubs need to be involved with local politicians. The AMSC board should consider meeting with local politicians during our national specialties.

Dear Miniature Schnauzer Lover,
We are writing to you to let you know about a new study that we are in the process of beginning at the Gastrointestinal Laboratory, College of Veterinary Medicine, at Texas A&M University. Our Lab has been working for more than 20 years on developing new tests for the diagnosis of gastrointestinal diseases in dogs and cats, and has helped thousands of veterinarians world-wide in the diagnosis of gastrointestinal diseases in small animal patients.

As you probably know, Miniature Schnauzers often have problems with pancreatitis and/or hyperlipidemia. These disorders are probably quite common even in dogs that appear to be healthy. However, little is known about the prevalence, etiology, and therapy of these diseases in this breed. We have decided to initiate a study and investigate the prevalence of hyperlipidemia and pancreatitis in Miniature Schnauzers that appear healthy. This will help us understand the scope of the problem and look for possible etiologies, preventive measures, and more effective therapies.

In order to begin this study we need to collect blood samples from as many Miniature Schnauzers as possible. We only need one blood sample from each dog accompanied by a brief questionnaire, and no follow up is necessary. For each dog, serum triglycerides (a form of lipid) and cPLI (a test specific for pancreatitis) concentrations will be measured, and we will inform you of the results. The cost of these tests is about \$50 per dog, but because we appreciate your help with this study, they will be performed for free. This way, you can have all your Miniature Schnauzers checked for hyperlipidemia and pancreatitis at no cost to you! We will also cover all shipping expenses. Any information

used in this study will remain strictly confidential.

If you are interested and can help us find out more about hyperlipidemia and pancreatitis in this beautiful breed, please let us know. Thank you very much!

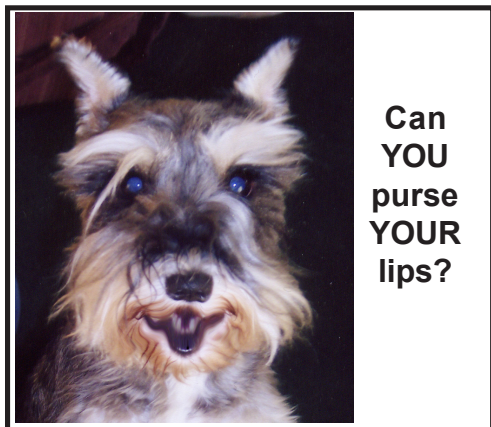
Minutes – October 7, 2006 AMSC Annual Board Meeting

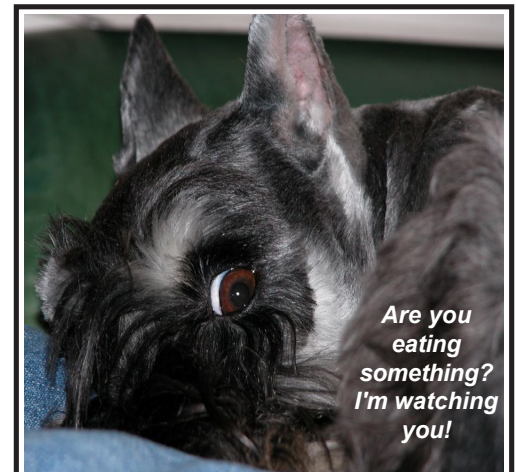

AKC Veterinary Network Certificate Program Helps Start Puppies on Lifelong Healthcare Plan

The secret to a long life is a great start.

For puppies, that means proper nutrition, training, grooming and healthcare.

The American Kennel Club understands puppy buyers have many decisions to make and has launched a program to help new owners give their dogs the best beginning.

Newly registered puppies now receive a certificate redeemable for a first office visit to a veterinary practice in the AKC Veterinary Network. More than 2,000 veterinarians around the country take part in the network; their contact information appears on the AKC web site.

United Airlines to Increase In-Cabin Limitation for Dogs Traveling to AKC/Eukanuba National Championship

NEW YORK, October 16, 2006 – The AKC has negotiated an agreement with United Airlines to relax restrictions on the number of dogs allowed to fly in-cabin to facilitate travel to the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship, AKC National Obedience Invitational, AKC Agility Invitational and related dog events. This special accommodation will be in effect for the period starting November 28, 2006 through December 5, 2006. This applies to all dogs traveling during this time period, regardless of whether they are competing in these events.

The temporary accommodation will allow two animals in First class, four in Business and six in Economy, doubling the traditional allowance. Dogs must still meet the usual in-cabin regulations. The policy applies to all United Airlines flights system wide but does NOT include United Express or Star Alliance partner carriers. Due to government regulation, the capacity limitations for pets traveling in cargo are not able to be amended.

In accordance with existing agreements between the AKC and United Airlines, United also offers discounts to anyone traveling to or from an AKC event. Depending on class of service and how far in advance of the travel date tickets are purchased, United offers 2% to 15% off published fares. Discounts apply only to the passenger ticket, and not to accompanying dogs.

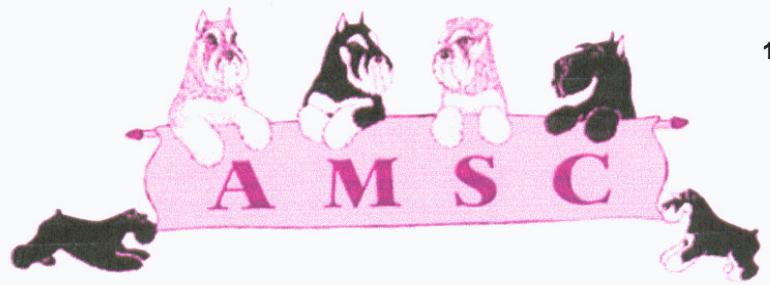

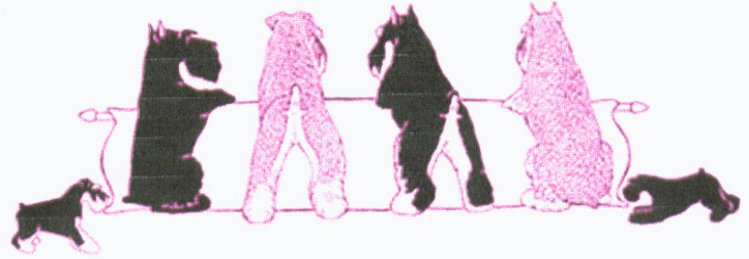

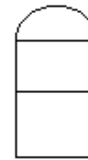
