FIFTY YEARS OF SCHNAUZERS

Fifty years ago I went to a dog show as a spectator and saw a couple of Miniature Schnauzers. I got back into my car, drove home and made my wife, Gene, go back to the Fairgrounds to see these dogs that we had never seen before. She agreed that they were "cute". Those of you who know her and know the way that she feels about dog shows will be able to appreciate this remark. After thinking it over for a while I went to a gentleman in town and placed an order for a puppy that was expected shortly.

At this time, the top size in the breed was set at 12-1/2 inches, so we had to be very careful to try to come up with one that would be in the standard. Even then the larger sized ones looked more like what the standard called for. My Topsy, a black and silver, (Registered name was Terpsichore) grew to the size of 11-1/4 inches. About this time the standard was changed to 14 maximum height. I showed Topsy several times and realized that she was a "point maker". I bred her one time, taking all the money that I got for her litter and spent it on one bitch, a Display daughter, who became Ch. Benrook Bethel, the foundation of my Bethel's prefix. Original, Huh?

Over the years as a breeder, and then as a judge, I have seen most of the dogs throughout the country, and I have watched the changes that have come about in the breed. Some are for the better and some are destined to destroy the general makeup of the Miniature Schnauzer.

Having read the article that Lori Bush has just come up with and then having been encouraged to try to write what I, as an oldtimer in the breed, believe that we should take some close scrutiny of what the breeders are doing, has precipitated this article.

Most of the breed that was brought into this country and bred from for years were very short backed, sometimes cloddy dogs with low tail sets and rounded croups. Then, along came the great Ch. Dorem Display, who gave the breed a lot of very good traits.

He was cursed by some in his day and being too refined and too Terrier Type. He gave the breed CLASS!

Our standard states that the Schnauzer should be ROBUST. How can one interpret robust to mean fine boned and slab sided? We still find dogs having insufficient bone and substance that are doing a lot of winning. This is wrong.

In doing away with rounded croups and low tailsets, the breeders are just about to go overboard. Tails have been a bane to the breed for years. It is my firm belief that a Schnauzer with a "Squirrel Tail" is totally wrong. In no way should the tail be set so high and so far forward that it detracts from the general makeup of the dog. A tail set and carried so that it points towards the head means that the dog is not built properly in the rear. And HORROR OF HORRORS are those with this sort of tail set and coupled with over-angulated hindquarters! They are not Schnauzers and they do not resemble the breed.

While the standard calls for the dogs to be short-backed, it also calls for them to be square or nearly square in build. A dog must have enough length for it to be flexible enough to do its work. And, yes, we should breed dogs to be able to do the work for which they were bred -- although it seems that most end up being "couch potatoes" and that isn't all bad. The dogs should be the same length from prosternum to rump as they are from the top of the withers to the ground. Folks, this is SQUARE.

If you have borne with me through this, let me expound just a little more on coats and colors.

There are 3 accepted colors in the breed, and oftentimes we find it very difficult to try to decide just what color a dog is. Black is Black is Black!! Gunmetal gray is not Black! Dark brown is not Black! Black and Silver is Black with Grey markings! Salt and Pepper is a dog with the agouti coloring made up of black

It is wonderful to note that out of the eleven awards, seven Miniature Schnauzers have earned their breed Championships. We have a nice variety of other titles earned too, as you can see. Three applicants earned their JE title, or Junior Earthdog title. In the obedience arena, at the high end of this sport, three applicants earned the UD title. The Utility Dog title is the top of the line in obedience titles as the dog must work from signals, complete scent work and work away from the trainer. The UD title is the third, and most difficult, obedience title. It must be earned before going on to obtain the UDX and OTCH titles, which are multi faceted titles. Other obedience titles were earned by our applicants as well. The CD title, or Companion Dog title was earned by three teams, and the CDX, or Companion Dog Excellent title was earned by five teams! The CD is the first title earned in obedience competitions, after which you may compete for your CDX title, and then the UD, etc.

Agility was certainly not left out and our applicants range from one MACH titled dog – which is the Master Agility Champion, the pinnacle of agility, to three Novice Agility titles, the NA and NAJ. The NAJ is the Novice Agility Jumpers title. In between, we have four teams with the MX and MXJ titles. These are the Master Agility and Master Agility Jumpers title, which require 10 qualifying runs in each of the Standard and Jumpers classes at the Excellent, or top, level. Three teams have earned their AX and AXJ titles – which is the Agility Excellent and Agility Excellent Jumpers title. To top off the agility range, we even have a Mini with Agility Preferred titles as well as the regular agility titles Preferred classes are for dogs that would like to compete at a lower jump height with more course time.

To round out this active group, we can even include a Tracking title. A TD, or Tracking Dog title was earned by one team, Sharon Bloss & Daisy.

The AMSC can be truly proud that we have our Miniature Schnauzers titling in every category offered for the Versatility Award. It is truly amazing what our wonderful Miniature Schnauzers can achieve as evidenced by the accomplishments of these award recipients.

FROM THE AKC.....

AKC Responsible Dog Ownership Day is September 17

The American Kennel Club has declared Friday, September 17, "AKC Responsible Dog Ownership Day," and announced hundreds of events to be held nationwide throughout the month of September. The goal of the initiative - being held for the second year - is to educate first-time dog owners about the responsibilities of dog ownership and help current owners enhance their relationships with their pets.

"AKC Responsible Dog Ownership Day helps bring attention to the fact that dog ownership, while immensely rewarding, should not be entered into lightly. It's crucial to understand the commitment involved and learn as much as you can about dogs and your specific breed before bringing home a new four-footed family member," says AKC spokeswoman Gail Miller.

All AKC-affiliated dog clubs as well as many other dog and pet-related organizations have been invited to participate by holding public events in their communities. Activities will include AKC Canine Good Citizen tests, obedience/agility demonstrations, microchipping clinics, breed rescue information, therapy dog/service dog demonstrations, safety around dogs for kids, fundraisers and many, many, more entertaining and educational events.

To date, over 200 clubs and organizations have signed on. Listings of all events can be found and searched by state here. The site will be updated weekly to reflect new additions.

On Saturday, September 18, 2004, the AKC will hold a flagship event in New York City's Madison Square Park, where local dog clubs are being invited to host information tables and conduct demonstrations. The AKC's Raleigh, NC office will also hold its own AKC Responsible Dog Ownership Day celebration on that day in Millbrook Exchange Park.

"If you are considering bringing a dog into your life, these events are an ideal way to meet canine experts and learn about the resources in your area. AKC dogs clubs can assist dog owners with everything from training to locating a reputable breeder, and we encourage everyone to attend - whether a dedicated dog lover or new pet owner," adds Miller.

Beggars' Holiday

Training your dog to take a permanent vacation from begging will help it grow up.

We have all experienced dogs begging; if not our own dogs, then our friends' dogs. We know the moist-eyed stare, the importuning paw, the heavy head on our knee under the table, the soft whining. We know the small dog's leaping, lapping, yapping and nipping that says Gimme, gimme, gimme. These behaviors compel us to respond with attention, food or whatever it takes to stop the begging.

Rally: The AKC's Newest Sport

Rally is a sport in which the dog and handler proceed at their own pace through a course of directional signs in a manner similar to Rally Car Racing. The signs are numbered sequentially in the ring to indicate the course the handler must take. The dog and handler team heel from sign to sign and perform the exercises indicated on the sign at each location. Each sign contains an exercise illustrated with symbols.

Rally was designed to create an obedience program that emphasizes fun and excitement for the dog, handler and spectator. It provides a natural approach to the performance. The handler is able to communicate with the dog through the entire course, and the emphasis is on teamwork between the dog and handler. Less precision is required than in traditional obedience.

One major change from traditional obedience is that, not only are you allowed to talk to your dog in the ring --- you're encouraged to do so! Handlers are permitted to talk, praise, encourage, clap hands, pat legs, or use any verbal means of encouragement, including additional commands and signals with no penalty.

Another appealing feature of Rally is the variability of courses. A specific number of exercises (depending on the level) are chosen from a list of exercises and signs. Each sign indicates an exercise that may be arranged in different orders for any course.

Many of the exercises in Rally originated from exercises used in training for competition obedience, often referred to as "doodling". These exercises are based on different moves used to train, polish and proof many of the obedience exercises, especially heeling.

AKC has developed three levels of competition - Novice, Advanced and Excellent. Four titles may be attained - (RN) Rally Novice, (RA) Rally Advanced, (RE) Rally Excellent and (RAE) Rally Advanced Excellent. Each title, when earned, may be used as a suffix to the dog's AKC registered name.

Rally is currently being held as a non-regular class at AKC events. It will become a regular (titled) event on January 1, 2005. For more information about Rally, click here.

and lighter colored BANDING of the hair. This is what gives the dog the distinctive salt and pepper coloring. A dog without the banded coat is an improper color. And, please, no dying!!!

I can remember the late Billy Kendrick, an all breed judge of great fame and wisdom, telling me years ago that "They are ruining your breed". He was talking about the fluffy, soft furnishings on the breed. In the old days, we wanted the leg and whisker furnishings to be very crisp to the touch and not soft and silky.

I believe that the breeders should be striving to breed dogs that will retain the type that was made up for the breed, rather than to try to "Pretty" it up. To the old-timers, a proper dog with proper size, substance of correct proportions and proper tail set and carriage is a joy to behold. Let's not attempt to change the breed to make it look like other breeds.

THIS 'n THAT

EUROPE - PET MICROCHIPPING Europe and all of its trading partners have now mandated microchipping as a condition of positive identification. This rule applies to pets being shipped in and out of the EU. Switzerland's Federal Council has taken this even further. They introduced compulsory microchipping of all dogs. The goal is to have all dogs clearly marked by 2007. Currently about 25% of all Swiss bred dogs are microchipped. It is mandatory in five of the country's 26 counties. Americans should expect that the US government might consider a microchip requirement for pets being shipped.

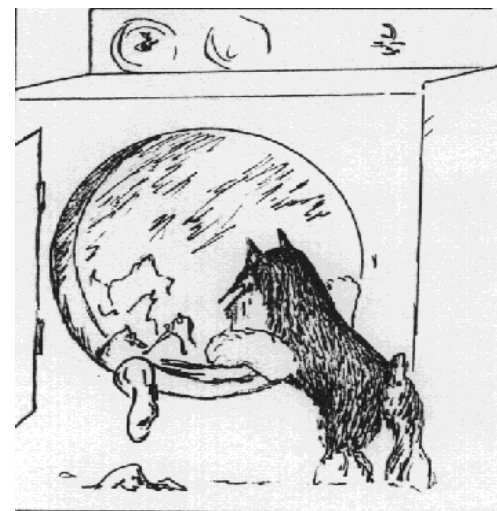
AKC DNA CONSULTANT. Elaine A. Ostrander, Ph.D., will serve as a consultant to AKC's DNA department. Ostrander will work closely with the staff and Board of directors of the AKC. With her involvement in the sequencing of the canine genome and its completion, she is the ideal person to bring into the AKC. The department will focus on DNA banking, canine health, and the integrity of the registry. Dr. Ostrander is a member of the Clinical Research Division at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and Head of the Program in Genetics. She is also an Affiliate Professor of Zoology and Genome Sciences at the University of Washington. She has been awarded the Burroughs Wellcome Fund Innovation Award in Functional Genomics and has received numerous grants from the AKC Canine Health Foundation (including mapping

of the canine genome). Her recent report, "Genetic Structure of the Purebred Dog" <http://www.akcchf.org/news/press/releases/2004/introelain.htm> appeared in the journal Science.

Human DNA separates one person from another, but 99.9 percent, is exactly the same as any other person's DNA. (Identical twins are the exception, with 100 percent similarity). Differences in the sequence of DNA among individuals are called genetic variation. It is the genetic variation that is used to explain some of the differences among people, such as eye color and blood group. Genetic variation also plays a role in whether a person has a higher or lower risk for getting particular disease. Single gene differences in individuals account for some traits and diseases, such as the ABO blood group, cystic fibrosis and sickle cell disease. More complex interrelationships among multiple genes and the environment are responsible for many of the other common diseases, such as diabetes, cancer, stroke, Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, depression, alcoholism, heart disease, arthritis and asthma. The genetic variation research studies look at how genetic variation relates to diseases, responses to drugs and environmental factors.

To keep breeders updated on genetic variation research here are some things that genetic variation studies are aimed at:

- Discovering and typing single nucleotide polymorphisms (SNPs) and other forms of genetic variation on a large scale across the genome.
- Developing high-resolution maps of genetic variation and haplotypes.
- Developing methods for the large-scale experimental and statistical analysis of SNPs, other forms of genetic variation, haplotypes and complex traits.
- Developing statistical methods that relate to genetic variation in phenotypes.

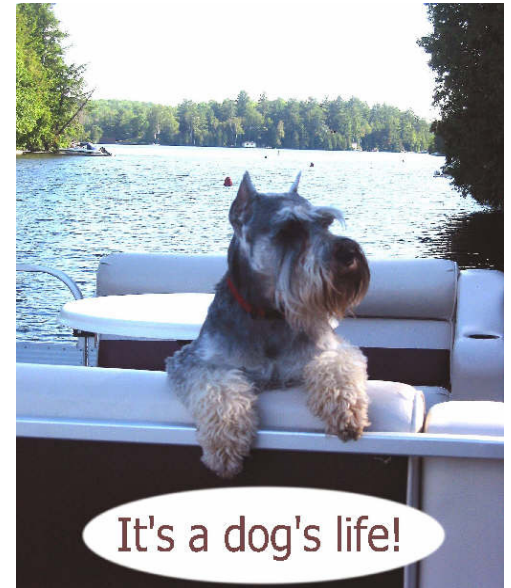
