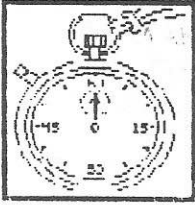

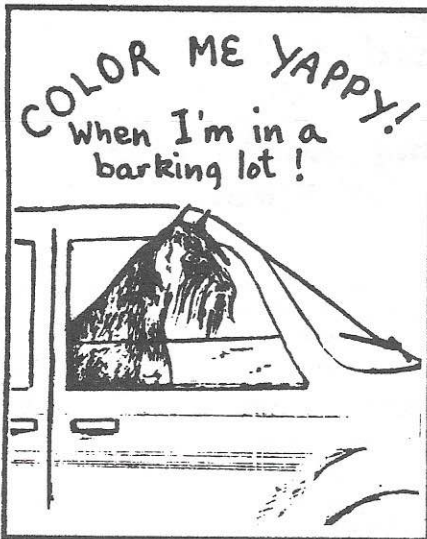
SECRETARY'S REPORT June 24, 1994



AMSC BOARD MEETING MINUTES

The meeting of the Board of Governors of the American Miniature Schnauzer Club, Inc. was held on Friday, June 24, 1994 at the California State University, Long Beach, CA.

Those present were: Carma Ewer, President; Susan Atherton, Secretary; Vera Potiker, Treasurer, also CJC; Jinx Gunville, also Policy Committee; Wyoma Clouss, also Judges Education; Jane Gilbert, also Public Awareness; John Constantine, also Eye Committee; Yvonne Phelps; Beverly Pfaff, NCMSC; Marcia Feld, CMSC, also Health; Marilyn Cooper, GMSC. Committee Chairpersons: Gene Matic, June Show

Chairman; Mildred Schultz, Rescue. Guests: Patty Ledgerwood, Anne Lockney, John Hoffman, Jane Azavedo, Mary Alford.

The President, Carma Ewer, opened the meeting at 5:40 pm. Introductions were made of those in attendance. There were 8 Board Members present, therefore requiring six affirmative votes to carry motions. The President reminded the Board that in the voting process, an abstention equated to a "no" vote.

The preliminary agenda was presented and unanimously adopted on a motion by J. Gunville, seconded by J. Gilbert. The minutes of the April 1, 1994 Board Meeting were published in *AMSCOPE* and copies were mailed to Board members prior to the meeting. The minutes were approved on a motion by J. Constantine seconded by W. Clouss.

The Secretary's report was presented, showing a current membership of 457 (456 regular + 1 life), a decrease of 7 compared to last year at this time. Twenty-six Local Clubs held 16 Miniature Schnauzer Specialties so far in 1994. Comparison of April 1994 and April 1993 Specialty Shows indicated an increase of 2 competing in the classes and an increase of 5 in Sweepstakes. The Secretary's Report was accepted on a motion by J. Constantine seconded by B. Phelps.

Correspondence brought to the attention of the Board included: letters from International KC wanting to update the Mini Schnauzer description used during their groups. After discussion, the Board decided to let Public Relations committee re-write the description. Correspondence sent out by the Secretary included all turn-around

forms from AKC to the appropriate clubs; Meeting notice and copy of Board Minutes to approximately 55 officers, governors, chairpersons, delegates. All other correspondence was distributed to the appropriate committees.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Vera Potiker showing an operating balance on June 23, 1994 of \$15,612.36 which reflects \$5786.28 more than last year. Vera pointed out that we have collected \$1555.00 from the trophy fund. A rebate of \$95.84 was realized from the April '94 Specialty. Report approved on a motion by S. Atherton, seconded by J. 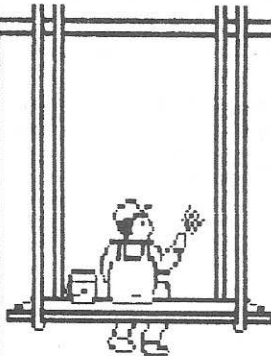
BLACK RIBBONS

The AKC Delegate, John Gulbin, had no report.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS**Special Committees:**

April '94 Specialty: Barbara Schulenberg is the new Show Chairman. The Board requested a Sean O'Conner memorium page in the catalogue for the show and asked Barbara to take care of the matter.

June 1994 Specialty: Gene Matic, June '94 Show Chairmas, has everything in order for tomorrow's show with an entry of 71 and 28 in Sweeps.

Fall '94 Specialty: Carol Patterson, Show Chairman, reported that she had contacted Ashbey-Nutting productions about taping the Mtg.Co. Specialty. They would tape the show adding a title identifying each dog by name and number as well as the appropriate marked section of the catalog. They want exclusive rights to produce our Specialty and the cost of the tape would be \$45. for the first tape and \$35. dollars each for 2 tapes, depending on the size of the entry. (about 100 dogs per 2 hour tape). After discussion, the Board approved the motion by S.Atherton, seconded by J.Gunville, that the Specialty will not be taped. Carol also reported that the Montgomery Inn is in bankruptcy so Joyce Brubaker has contacted Guest Quarters regarding the Annual Dinner. The meals would be \$30. for chicken and \$35. for prime rib. J.Gilbert moved, J.Constantine seconded, that we ask Joyce to contact Charlies Place or a more reasonable restaurant if possible, otherwise we will use the Guest Quarters this one time.

1. **AMSCOPE:** Carma reported that

The Secretary asked that the local clubs include the AMSC Delegate with their listing of club officers.

2. **ADOA:** Carol Somers sent no report.

3. **Constitution and By-Laws:** David Kirkland sent no report.

4. **CJC:** Vera Potiker had no report.

5. **Finance:** Vera Potiker reported everything is in order.

6. **Guidelines:** David Kirkland sent a report that George Downs will do the typing for this committee. David needs updates from the following committees: Rescue, Public Education, Obedience, Eye Committee Coordinator, Annual Dinner and the Officers. The updates are to be sent to David for editing.

7. **Health:** Marcia Feld reported she wants to do a survey in coordination with the U.of Penn. to find out the current health problems in our breed. The problem listing will be obtained from the University and published in the AMSCOPE with a check list to be answered anonymously. This was approved on a motion by J.Gilbert, seconded by J.Constantine. Carma Ewer will have the transcription of Dr. Gretchen Schmidt's presentation in Chicago ready for printing in the August AMSCOPE.

8. **Insignia:** No report.

9. **Judges Selection:** Gwen Darby reported that the mailing is late due to the mailing labels being sent to the wrong person.

10. **Judges Education:** Wyoma Clouss reported she had talked with Carolyn Urban of Delaware Valley MSC and there will be a separate room in the basement for the Judges Education Seminar which will start two hours before Sweepstakes judging. An Instructional Packet for those asked to do a seminar for judges is now available from Wyoma. This packet includes an outline from the *Illustrated Breed Standard* with overhead overlays and will be sent on a loan basis - two checks sent in advance, \$20.00 refundable deposit and then a check to cover the postage. In summary of discussion regarding the availability of Illustrated Discussions to be supplied for selling at the Breed seminars, please contact Jane Gilbert.

12. **Liason:** Barbara Hall reported sending all local clubs the latest AKC policy pertaining to the sweepstakes judging and exhibiting, and the Public Education Report regarding the pet breeding and selling and what the localbreeders can do to help reach this segment of the population.

13. **Local Club Bulletin:** June Shanklin - no report.

14. **Membership:** Gwen Darby reported the application of Debby Hollander. It was moved by S.Atherton, seconded by B.Phelps that we bring the application to the table, approved. Gwen had contacted all the persons involved and felt that there were no problems. On a motion by W.Clouss, seconded by J.Gunville, the Board approved her membership application. In the transfer of chairmen of this committee, the names of the prior applicants were not published and therefore will be added to the new applicants to be published and voted on at the October meeting.

15. **Obedience:** Bill Oxendale -no report.

16. **Policy:** Jinx Gunville - no report.

17. **Public Awareness:** Jane Gilbert presented her report of the income and expenses for the period of Jan. 1

to May 31, 1993. On a motion by J.Gilbert, seconded by B.Phelps, the Board approved adding the pet groomers sheet to the *Grooming Chart* providing that the cost is not prohibitive.

18. Public Education Coordinator: Margaret Pratt sent her report regarding the AKC

encouraging the National Clubs to become active in the Public Coordinator "PEC" program. She had received a call from the AKC regarding the AMSC efforts on this program. Carma will write AKC a letter describing our efforts: individual members provide education when selling puppies or when asked about stud referral; breeder referral liason; white miniature committee; ads in *Dog Fancy*; local clubs educational activities; and that we are investigating having the AKC insert an educational letter with each Miniature Schnauzer registration. The Board directed Margaret to contact the Golden Retriever Club regarding the AKC's distribution of their information sheet included with the registration papers of all Golden Retrievers. Anne Lockney will investigate the Golden Retriever networking within the States.

19. Publicity: Marilyn Cooper reported she is welcoming any suggestions for Gazette articles.

20. PRA: Carl Barth reported that he had been in communication with Dr. Aquirre and that he had established the DNA for PRA in Irish Setters. Now he is ready to work on another breed. Dr. Aquirre has two proposals:

#1 Breed Intensive Project: AMSC would donate \$100,000.00 for two researchers to work only on Miniature Schnauzers;

#2 Umbrella Project: several breeds would pool together and commit \$5,000.00 each for five years. He said the monies would only go for the salaries of the researchers. Carma

asked Dr.Barth to contact Dr.Aquirre for the proposal in writing and that it be mailed to all Board members prior to the October Board meeting. The Board also asked Dr. Barth to investigate any other research on eyes being done at this time. Carma asked John Hoffman to investigate fund raising and he was instructed to contact Jean Heath, a prior chairman of a fund raising effort.

21. Rescue: Millie Shultz reported that there are 16 Miniature Schnauzer rescue sources listed in "Project Breed." V.Potiker moved, seconded by J.Gilbert, that Millie get a current issue of this publication, motion carried. Millie asked all local clubs that currently have rescue programs to send her their information and she will have to contact other breed rescue programs for input to assist her in establishing uniform guidelines for AMSC.

22. Trophy: Gene Matic reported that the trophies arrived and are ready for tomorrow.

23. Urinary Disease: Marsha Libertof sent an update on renal disease that will be printed in AMSCOPE.

24. Use of the Miniature Schnauzer in Advertising and White Miniature Schnauzer: Mary Roberts sent her report regarding the advertisement of white minis in the papers. The Board asked that she coordinate information for the local clubs to establish a White Committee and work on this problem locally. The Board also asked her to contact the AKC and see how

many of the "other" colors were registered in 1993.

ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS

The new applicants were not published so voting could not take place.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Nominating Committee: The slate of officers submitted by the

committee is as follows: President - Jane Gilbert; Vice-President - David Kirkland; Treasurer - Vera Potiker; Secretary - Susan Atherton; 1998 Board of Governors: Marilyn Cooper, Mildred Shults, Janice Rue, David Wortham. The Board approved a motion by J. Gunville, seconded by V.Potiker, to accept the committee's recommendations.

2. Veteran Sweepstakes: M.Feld suggested that we offer this class at our National Specialty. It was moved by J.Gilbert, V. Potiker seconded, that we have a Veteran Sweepstakes in 1995 at GWTA, motion carried. Vera Potiker will be in charge of this non-regular class and the classes offered will be: 7-9 yrs (in stripped coat); 9 and older (may be clipped). Awards: Best Veteran Dog, Best Veteran Bitch and Best Veteran. Rosettes for all entered over 9 years old.

There being no further business, the Board unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m. on a motion by S. Atherton, seconded by J. Gunville. The President reminded all to stay for the Hospitality that was arranged by Gene Matic.
