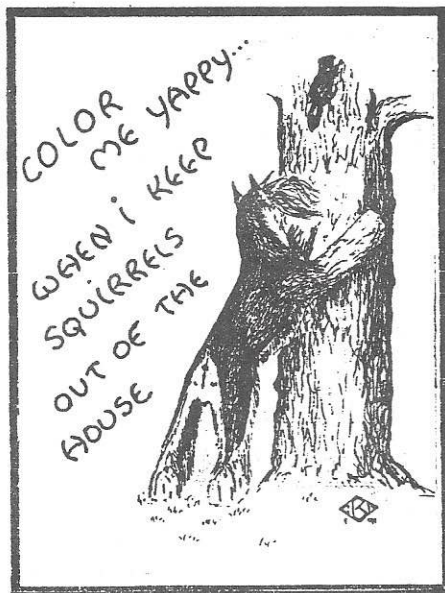

RENAL DISEASE UPDATE

In a conversation with Dr. Carl Osborne of the University of Minnesota, he gave me an update on the status of urolithiasis in Miniature Schnauzers.

He stated that incidence of bladder stones in Miniature Schnauzers is still higher than in other breeds. He also reported that, unfortunately, there has been an increase in the incidence of calcium oxalate calculi. The problem with this kind of stone is that it tends to occur more often in males than in females; more often in older animals; they tend to recur, and there is, so far, no treatment other than surgery.

In previous discussions about calcium oxalate stones, Dr. Osborne indicated that there seemed to be some correlation with parathyroid hormone and Vitamin D, but there is need for more research to be done in this area.

Since Dr. Morton is no longer with the University of Illinois, I've been unable to get additional information about juvenile renal disease.

We would appreciate hearing from members who have had or are having a urinary tract problem in their dog. Please send whatever information you have been given about the kind of stones and/or disease they have, and a pedigree on the dog. As it has for the past twenty years, all information is held confidential.

THE BEST CHICKEN (or LIVER) COOKIES YOU EVER MADE

1 lb chopped chicken or turkey or 1lb beef liver
1 cup whole wheat flour
1 cup corn meal
1/4 cup brewer's yeast
1tbsp garlic powder

If you use the beef liver, liquify it in a cuisenart or blender. Otherwise, mix all ingredients in a large bowl. Because there are no liquids, the mixing is a little difficult (but the product is worth it.)

Spread out to a thickness of 1/2 inch on an ungreased cookie sheet. I use a piece of saran wrap on top of the mixture and roll it with a rolling pin.

Bake in a 350° oven for about 15

minutes, or until the cookies appear dry. Remove from the oven and cut immediately into convenient pieces. You can use a cookie cutter for shapes or just cut into 1/2 " chunks. Lift the cookies with a spatula and turn them a bit. Put them back into the oven for about 5 more minutes.

That's it! My "kids" sit in front of the oven waiting for the product.

The cookies should be refrigerated or frozen. I use them for bait for both conformation and obedience. They aren't messy and you won't suffer from "liver pockets".

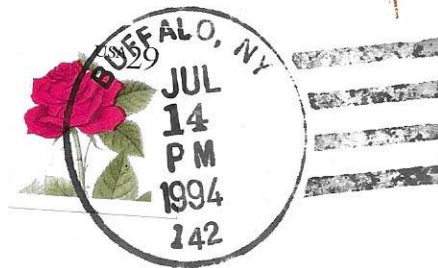
