For newcomers, it's an opportunity to learn more about our breed by comparing very correct dogs to one another, meet established breeders and potential mentors, and ask questions. It's essential that we all welcome these questions -- and return our interest in the dogs that others bring.

There is no fee, but you must register so that we can provide name tags and a small sign with your dog's registered name, call name, and age.

When and Where: Thursday, October 1 at Hatboro, approximately 3 pm to 5 pm.

The club will be providing pizza & bottled water for all.

Dogs will be available for "hands-on" review by attendees, and gaited in the ring.

The Details:

- * Registration by September 20th.
- * Participating dogs must be comfortable with being examined by people they're unfamiliar with. Dogs will be introduced in the ring, before moving to tables.
- * Attendees will be instructed to be gentle and considerate, and only one person at a time may approach each dog for "hands on".
- * Bring a crate, grooming table with noose, and lead for each dog participating. (Please let us know if you need help with equipment).
- * Bring handouts for attendees including owner's name and contact information, 3 generation pedigree, photo, health testing performed, accomplishments, and any information on offspring. (Basic template provided).
